Shuttle

We will provide shuttle service from the Boise Centre on the Grove to Spring Hills Suites and Holiday Inn on Park Center. Hotels

1. Please get your hotels booked as soon as possible. My understanding is SpringHill Suites and Holiday Inn are the only hotels with availability. We are working on some transportation solutions but I won't know anything until next week after the BPA Board Meeting, so I will update you at that time.

Pre-submits

1. There are two different types of pre-submit events.
2. There are the events that are the same as National
3. There are the “special” events (marked by an asterisk in the guide)
4. These events are the IT/Publishing events that we do not have the software to support.
5. The teacher will choose a time between Jan. 23 and Feb 3 to administer the test for their student
6. The student will upload the test and the event will be graded
7. To submit pre-submit events, **after** you have registered your students there will be a button at the bottom of the registration list. It says:
